

## ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION: FRIENDS OF THE PARK FOREST HEALTH DEPARTMENT

### Article 5. Other Provisions.

**Purpose:** The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

**Inurement of Income:** No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

**Dissolution:** Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustees, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, will dispose of all assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine.

**Board of Trustees:** For the FRIENDS OF THE PARK FOREST HEALTH DEPARTMENT, the Board of Trustees and the Board of Directions are the same.
